An Orthodox Interpretation of The Twelve Steps of the Alcoholics Anonymous Program

The Little Red Book evolved from a series of notes originally prepared for “Twelve Step” suggestions to A.A. beginners.

Recently I have been reading a little bit each day about the steps in this book. I’ve found it so helpful that I want to share some of it.

I’m currently reading about Step Five and it says: “If your inventory has been thorough, ‘you are in a position to pocket your pride,’ to tell a story ‘that will illuminate every twist of character, every dark cranny of the past.’ You have no reason to doubt the psychological and spiritual value offered. You will be well rewarded for your effort and will find yourself at a loss to express in words the gratification that will be yours. *Understanding of such things comes only with experience.*”

“Interpretation of the deep significance of admitting our wrongs to God, ourselves and another human being is logically summed up by saying, ‘Once we have taken this step, withholding nothing, we are delighted. We can look the world in the eye. We begin to feel the nearness of our Creator. *We have had* certain spiritual beliefs, but NOW WE BEGIN TO HAVE A SPIRITUAL EXPERIENCE.’ ” p. 83
